STUDIO RULES

- Respect for the instructors is crucial. Please also respect your peers and their families.
- Please wear appropriate dress code (SEE BELOW), or you student may be asked to sit out.
- Students who are disruptive to the class will be asked to sit down or leave the class. If multiple defenses occur, the student may be asked to have a meeting with his or her parent.
- Please walk in the studio quietly if another class is in session.
- Please keep the studio clean.
- Please do not hang on the barres or touch the mirrors.
- Please do not chew gum in class.
- Please do not bring food into the studio unless you will be in class for an extended period of time (more than two classes/privates). Otherwise, you may bring bottled water only and drink it when you are given a water break during class.
- Please use the restroom before class begins or at the end of class.
- Please be on time for class. It is important for a proper warm-up and it also interrupts the class when students walk in late.
- There will be no more than three (3) unexcused absences permitted. If you miss more than three classes, you must schedule a private to make up the missed time OR join a session of another comparable class during the week.

DRESS CODE

Dance and theatre are serious creative disciplines and begin with the way a student dresses for class. Therefore, appropriate attire is required as follows:

Combo Classes

Please wear a leotard, pink tights, pink ballet shoes (ballet or jazz), and black tap shoes. Ballet skirts, dresses, and tutus are all acceptable. No jeans.

Ballet Classes

Leotard, pink or nude tights, pink ballet shoes (split sole, canvas or leather for our older students); Hair secured in a bun or high ponytail. Warm-ups may only be worn at the beginning of class. No jeans.

Boys - Please wear black dance pants with white t-shirt, black or nude ballet shoes. No jeans.

Musical Theatre, Lyrical, Jazz, Tap, and Hip Hop Classes

Please wear black jazz or yoga pants, tights, comfortable pants or jazz shorts, comfortable top or leotard, and appropriate shoes. No sandals or flip-flops will be permitted. No jeans.

Jazz Shoes - Black or tan jazz shoes (pull on or ties); Foot undies are also acceptable.

Tap Shoes - Black tap shoes.

Lyrical - Barefoot or foot undies.

Hip Hop - Black sneakers, hip hop shoes, or jazz shoes. (OK for Musical Theatre classes, as well.)

No "street" clothes will be allowed.

Hair must be pulled up out of your face. If you have bangs, please secure with a bobby pin off the face.

Acting/Singing Classes

Comfortable attire and shoes. Please be sure you wear clothing that allows for movement!
